WRIGHT-HENNEPIN ELECTRIC VEHICLE RIDER

I. Availability

Available to all members served by Wright-Hennepin Cooperative Electric Association (Cooperative) who request a discounted interruptible rate for a dedicated electric vehicle charging station connection. Service will be single or multi-phase, 60 Hertz, at available secondary voltages. If a member selects billing under this rider, the member must remain on this rider for a minimum of one year.

II. Conditions of Service

- A. Charging station usage will be metered separately.
- B. The member may be required to enter into an agreement with the Cooperative.
- C. The member will pay the cost and arrange to install all special equipment and/or additional switching mechanisms necessary to permit electric vehicle charging control.
- D. A member wishing to disconnect from the Electric Vehicle Rider shall make that request in writing and if disconnected, will be denied rejoining for a period of two years from the disconnection date.

III. Determination of Monthly Rate

- A. Energy Charge closed to members with an Eaton Meter
 - 1. 12:00 PM to 10:00 PM @ \$0.30154 per kWh
 - 2. All other hours @ \$0.06434 per kWh
- B. Energy Charge for members with an Eaton Meter
 - 1. 5:00 PM to 10:00 PM @ \$0.30154 per kWh
 - 2. 5:00 AM to 5:00 PM @ \$0.12782 per kWh
 - 3. 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM @ \$0.06434 per kWh
