

Wright-Hennepin Cooperative Electric Association (WH) and Wright-Hennepin Holding Company (WH Holding) are proud to provide scholarships to assist students of members in furthering their education.

WH scholarship program

WH began a scholarship program in 1988 and has since awarded almost \$710.000 to local students.

Money for the scholarship fund comes from unclaimed capital credits and donations from WH Holding, which provides the legal structure for WH Security, Wright-Hennepin Inernational Response Center and WH Services (WH Appliance Repair and WH Tree Services).

By funding the program this way, the scholarship awards are not funded through members' electric rates.

One at-large scholarship is awarded annually, in the amount of \$1,500.

Eligibility

High school seniors living in the local area are eligible to apply if they are planning to enroll full-time in an undergraduate program for the next academic year at any two-year or four-year college, university or vocational technical school in the United States.

Please note: If you attend one of the high schools that receives a scholarship from WH already, you are not eligible for this at-large scholarship. You must apply through your high school.

At-large application process

- ☐ Proof your parent/guardian is a WH member, by including your electric account number on the application.
