### WRIGHT-HENNEPIN TO HOST 86<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL MEETING

**Rockford, Minn. (March 22, 2023)** — Wright-Hennepin Cooperative Electric Association (WH) will host its 86<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting on Thursday, April 20, 2023. The theme of this year’s meeting is “Reliability You Can Depend On.” The meeting will be held at WH’s Rockford headquarters, located at 6800 Electric Drive.

The meeting returns in full-scale for the first time since 2019. Registration will begin at 4 p.m., with a complimentary pork chop dinner served from 4:30 to 6:45 p.m. Multiple informational booths will be available for members to enjoy, along with plenty of activities for all ages, including the return of Bingo. A local Girl Scout troop will provide activities and crafts for children ages 2-10 from 4:30 to 8 p.m. All children registered in the children’s area will be entered to win one of four children’s bicycles.

The business meeting will begin at 7 p.m. and is expected to run for one hour. WH’s 2023 Annual Meeting will include a financial report, WH and WH Holding leadership reports, and results of the Board of Directors elections for Districts 2, 5 and 7. A grand prize drawing of a 2013 Ford Fusion retired from WH’s fleet will immediately follow the business meeting. Members are automatically registered for the grand prize given away at the end of the business meeting and must be present to win. All registered members in attendance will receive a free pound of butter following the conclusion of the business meeting.

Free parking is available at WH headquarters, the Rockford Mall, Our Father’s Lutheran Church, and the Industrial Park. Shuttles will be available to bus members to and from the event.
