Terms of the WH Energy-Saving Rebate Program

- Rebate amount for AC is \$40 per ton up to a maximum of \$200 (5 ton).
 - o Member agrees to allow WH control up to 200 hours per cooling season. During the managing time, we will cycle your AC on and off during the time of control.
 - o Member must be on at least one other ESP to qualify.
- Rebates will be issued as a credit on your WH electric bill.
- AC unit must be installed within WH service territory.
- · AC unit must be on the Ouick Cash ESP.
- AC unit will be metered at the general service rate.
- Members with an AC receive a credit of \$5 applied to their electric account for the months **June through September**. The member must have a minimum general service usage of 200 kWh per month to qualify for the credit.
- Member is responsible for AC unit installation cost and maintenance of the AC unit.
- Members must verify with their contractor that the newly installed AC system is compatible with the WH Energy-Saving demand management system equipment and control strategy to ensure no forfeiture of their manufacturer's warranty.
- WH will provide installation of the load control device (receiver). WH will only pay for the standard installation of the load control device for the QCAC ESP.
- The ESP receiver equipment will need to be located outside the home.
- Please allow six to eight weeks for rebate processing after ESP installation.
- Form must be filled out completely. Incomplete forms will be returned.
- The ESP for the AC unit will be required to be in place for a minimum of five years.
- By applying for the rebate you are agreeing to the terms of the program.
- Does not apply to ductless systems.
- Must be purchased between January 1 December 31, 2024. Submit the completed rebate form and a copy of the original sales receipt within 90 days of purchase to:
